**BUDGET MESSAGE**

Dear Citizen:

The following budget is presented for your review as required by the statutes of the State of New Jersey. Prior to the actual budget, we have included an analysis of the proposed tax rate as compared to the actual tax rate for 2013.

The section entitled "Recap of Split Functions" reflects the total appropriation for a specific item of operating expenditure which is included in more than one area of the budget. In this way you may readily ascertain the total cost for that particular function of municipal expenditures.

Also included is an analysis of the municipality's budget "CAP". The CAP, as required by state statute, allows a 0.5% (or 3.5% if an ordinance was approved), increase over the previous year's budget with certain allowable adjustments.

The budget is presented in such a way that you may easily distinguish the prior year's budget and actual expenditures in comparison to this year's budget.

The State of New Jersey has required that a standardized "Flexible Chart of Accounts" be used, therefore all appropriations from 2013 and 2014 are comparable.

**I. Tax Rate**

As of the date of introduction of this budget, the Local and Regional School and County Tax Rates have not been determined. Therefore, the 2014 Tax Rate and levies are subject to rate revision when final certification is made by the County Board of Taxation.
