FEES: 65 years old and older:

FLU VACCINE AND PNEUMOCOCCAL VACCINE ARE FREE for people aged 65 and older with Medicare B. Must bring MEDICARE CARD and have PART B. Without Medicare B cost of flu is \$20. In addition, Blue Cross supplemental accepted. Medicare HMO not accepted.

FEES: Under 65 years old

FLU VACCINE: \$20

Insurance accepted for NJ Blue Cross plans and Traditional Medicaid (not Medicaid HMO)
Cash or check accepted . . . no credit cards

Due to a recent upgrade in the Township's tax software, property tax information can now be accessed via the Township Website at www.twp.fredon.nj.us.

1. Click on the [View Property Taxes Online](#) link and enter your Block and Lot or Last Name.
2. Property owners with multiple lots or farmland must access those properties individually.
3. Identify the payment due date to determine the amount due for the quarter
4. If past due, project the interest date to the date the payment will be **received in this office**, not today's date or the mailing date.

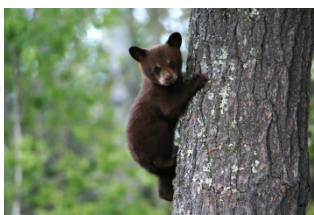

There are many small children playing in the area, bicycle riders and a number of residents walk their pets on the roads, sometimes after dark. Please also ask your teen drivers and their friends to **slow down** and share the road!

Be a Good Neighbor - Be Bear Aware



Fredon is home to all kinds of beautiful wildlife - including black bears. Black bears are getting a lot of attention these days, for the wrong reasons. They're venturing too close to homes and backyards, looking for food. Bears that look for food near your home or in your yard likely have learned bad habits from people who feed them intentionally, or unintentionally by carelessly leaving out food or garbage.

People who feed bears think they're helping them. But it only invites trouble. It can make them a nuisance or even aggressive. When that happens, the bears must be destroyed to protect your family and your neighbors. What's more, it's illegal to feed bears in New Jersey. Anyone who feeds bears could face a penalty of up to \$1,000 for each offense.

Here's what you can do to be a Good Neighbor - Be Bear Aware:

- **Use bear proof containers, if possible.**
- **Put out garbage on collection day, not the night before.**
- **Feed dogs and cats outside during daylight hours only. Remove uneaten food immediately.**
- **Feed birds only between December 1 and April 1 when bears are least active.**
- **Clean outdoor grills thoroughly after each use.**
