Electronics Waste Disposal Day

Saturday, July 22nd - Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority Electronics Waste Disposal Day, 7AM-2PM, 34 South Route 94, Lafayette.

Includes computers, printers, cell phones, televisions, VCR's DVD & CD's, fax & copiers, radios & stereos, etc. Limits: Up to 5 units per vehicle.

Effective January 1, 2011, the following items may no longer be placed curbside for bulk pick-up: **Televisions, Monitors, Computers, and Laptop Computers. Additionally, effective on January 31, 2017 the following items have been added to the list of items prohibited to be placed curbside for bulk or regular pick-up as they may no longer go into the regular waste stream: **Printers, FAX machines and copiers.** The next Electronics Waste Disposal Day will be held on October 14, 2017.**
